Ephesians 5: 1-2

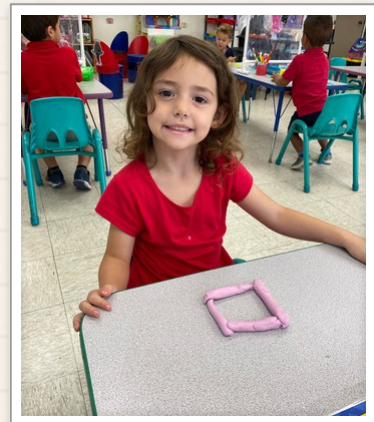


Update from Mrs. Buth & Mrs. E's TK Classroom

Well that's all for now. Check back with us soon to see what we are up to next!





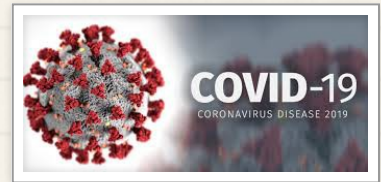
GET YOUR YARD SIGN AND REFORMATION RAIDERS FACE MASK WHILE SUPPLIES LAST!

Students are wearing face masks when necessary, keeping social distance when appropriate and cooperating with teacher instructions and guidance. Teachers are making time to clean high-touch surfaces, recess equipment, and restroom surfaces, too. Students and teachers are working together to engage in distance learning for the families who are unable to bring their students back to campus for in-person learning. Now that 4 weeks have passed, we are grateful to say that we have had no school community members fall ill with COVID-19 or experience known interaction with an infected person. This brings us to a few reminders:
