
Mr. Ross & Mrs. Bailey's classroom update

Reformation School - Hot Lunch Interest Survey

Do you need a break from packing the lunchbox? Would you like the ability to order a school lunch for your student? Ki's School Lunches is a program we had available to families during the 2019-2020 school year and we have an opportunity to use their service again this year. The Ki's website has quite a bit of information at https://kis.naturallunches.com/, including daily menus to view. The daily menu includes hot and cold sandwiches, salads, rice bowls and wraps - along with hot lunch options that vary day to day. Lunches begin at about \$6 and are very flexible - you can add side items in addition to a main food.

Lunches are delivered to school and to your child's classroom. Ordering is completed online and can be cancelled early in the morning if your child will unexpectedly be absent from school. Service on Wednesdays and/or Fridays is available to our school, if we have enough interest from families to make it worthwhile.
