It pleases God to keep the veil drawn on what the end of time and life in heaven will be like. Mostly. Even though he is holding back on information about the Great Surprise, just like a parent who makes her kids wait until Christmas to unwrap presents, he does put out little bits of the puzzle to encourage us, keep us fired up, and help sustain us in our struggles.

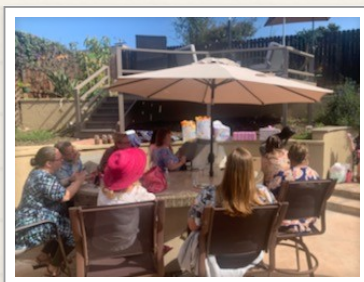
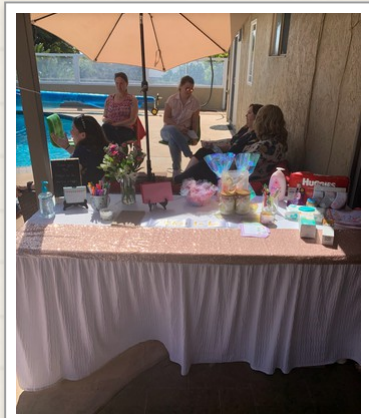

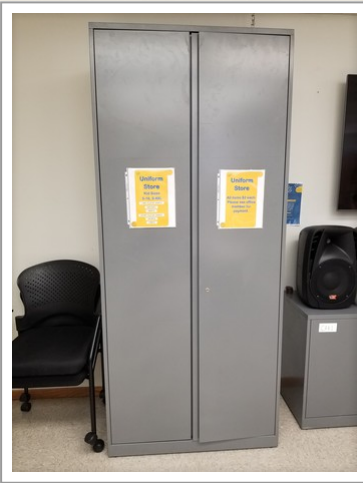
An opportunity to make an impact in our classrooms

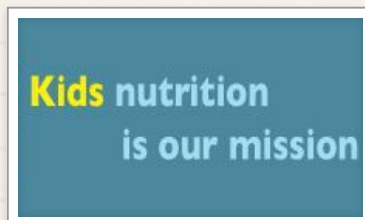
Earlier this month the 7/8th graders celebrated Pi Day. The students brought in pies and other things round!
