MESSAGE FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Where do we find teachers?

While some of our teachers have come to us through different paths, bringing with them wonderful and useful experiences, the majority of our teachers are trained through Martin Luther College in New Ulm, MN. Martin Luther College is owned and operated by the Wisconsin Evangelical Lutheran Synod (WELS). Formed from an amalgamation of Dr. Martin Luther College (founded in 1884) and Northwestern College (founded in 1865), Martin Luther College opened its doors to the next generation of church workers in 1995. While every institution has its strengths, Martin Luther College is distinctive. It is the WELS College of Ministry. It exists solely to train future pastors, teachers, and staff ministers for the public ministry in the Wisconsin Evangelical Lutheran Synod.

This college specifically trains teaches to serve in one of the synod's 369 early childhood education institutions, 291 elementary schools, or 26 Lutheran high schools. This is where I was trained as a teacher from 2004-2008 and received my Bachelor of Science degree in Elementary Education. Martin Luther College also offers many online and satellite courses for our teachers, preschool directors, principals, and pastors. This is where I am currently enrolled for my graduate studies. Once finished I will have my Master of Science in Educational Administration degree. They offer many more graduate studies including: educational technology, instruction, leadership, and special education.

This time of year is very exciting as the college has graduation this weekend. Along with graduation, all eligible students will receive an assignment to an elementary school or early childhood facility. These young people have studied for 4-5 years in God's Word, trained to become teachers, and now look forward to serving God's people somewhere in the United States at a WELS school just like ours. This year, we have been asking for God to bless us with a 1st grade teacher for the future. We have asked Martin Luther College to consider assigning a graduate to Reformation. We should be finding out very shortly whether or not we will be assigned one. We pray that the Lord blesses us with a worker for our 1st grade through this training process.

So, please pray with us. Pray for all of the graduates that are receiving their degree on Saturday, May 15th. Pray for all of those graduates receiving assignments into the ministry field. Pray that Reformation is blessed with one of these young people to serve here.


Ms. Ceci's Classroom Update






