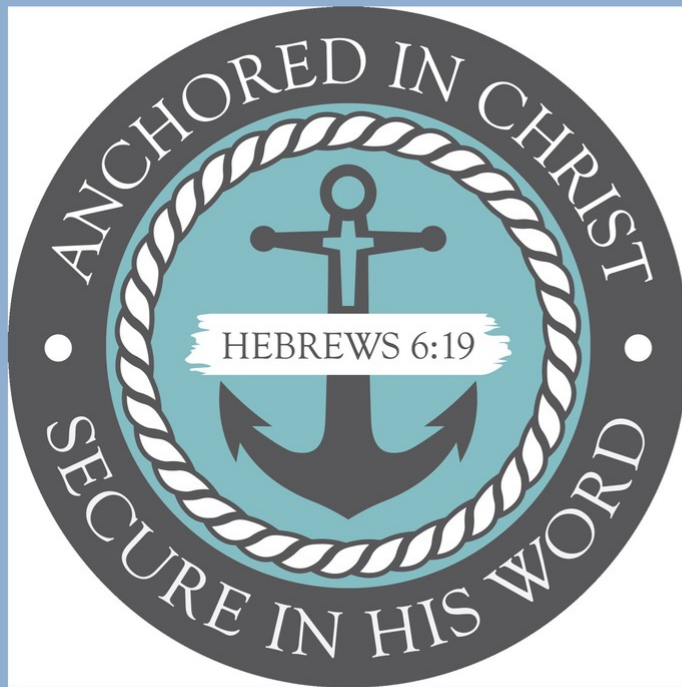

MESSAGE FROM THE PRINCIPAL

This **Sunday**, at our 8:00am and 10:30 am worship services, we have the privilege of officially welcoming Mr. Eric Matz, Mrs. Jessica Bohl, and Mrs. Jodi Bailey to Reformation as grade school teachers.

Every Christian has been given the task of sharing and proclaiming the message of salvation. Jesus commissioned every believer to "go into all the world and preach the gospel" (Mark 16:15). We do that in whatever situation God has placed us. All believers are to be ready to share the reason for the hope that they have in Christ. This is what we call personal ministry. These responsibilities and opportunities come from our Lord and Savior.

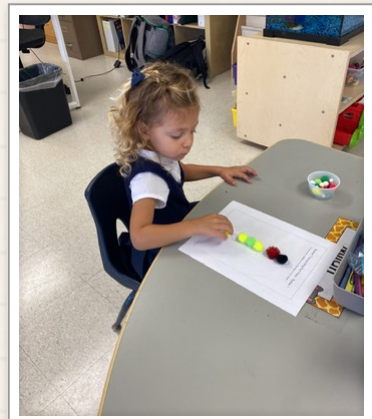
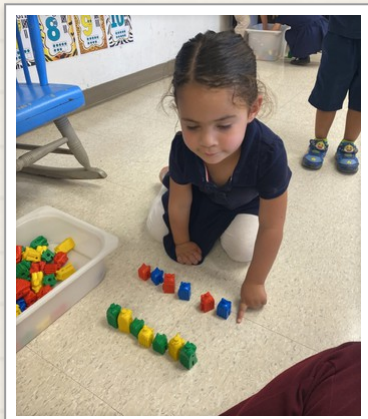

Update from Ms. Jen's Classroom

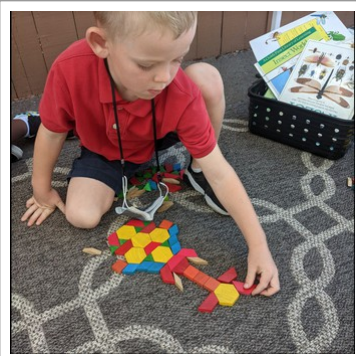

Ki's School Lunches – Order Today!

You can take a break from packing a lunchbox on Mondays and Thursdays by ordering from Ki's School Lunches! Reformation's first day of Ki's Lunches is Monday, September 13. K-8 Drop-Off and Pick-Up Times

A reminder for parents and guardians about K-8 student drop off and pick up timing: Drop off begins (driveway gate is opened) and classrooms open at 8:10am. Students brought to school before 8:10am should be signed into Shepherd's Care. The school day begins at 8:30am. K-8 classrooms are dismissed at 3:00pm (driveway gate is opened) and pick up continues until 3:20pm. Students on campus after 3:20pm will be signed into Shepherd's Care and must be picked up by 5:00pm. Please refrain from using your cell phone when you are driving on campus to drop off and pick up students.

Lost and Found

We encourage all families to label all your student's items (sweatshirts/sweaters, lunch bags, water bottles, etc.) so they can be easily returned to your student when found on campus.

If your student is missing an item, please contact his or her teacher for assistance in locating it.



Tech Tip

As many of you are aware, Reformation is a Goggle Workspace for Education School (formerly G Suite for Education). This means that all of the students are given Google accounts for use while they attend school.

In the upper grades, we use this for some of the homework the students have. The students who have Chromebooks also use this information to log into and use their devices.

One of the benefits of using Google Workspace for Education is that Reformation has complete control and can monitor what the students are doing while using these services and when they are on their Chromebooks.

Children in grades 3-8 have access to either a shared classroom Chromebook or they have their own Chromebook that they have purchased through the school. If you are interested in learning more about purchasing a Chromebook for your child, please contact Mr. Bohl.
