Christmas is the season of stuff that didn't actually happen. A magical snowman with a button nose. A bullied reindeer with a heartwarming story of acceptance. A mischievous elf who delights children and exhausts parents throughout the holidays.

But Christians' Christmas is different. Just ask Dr. Luke, the man who wrote the longest version of the Bible's Christmas history. In the original Greek, Luke began his account with the words, "It happened." Literally, "[It happened] **in those days that Caesar Augustus issued a decree**" (Luke 2:1). That same phrase, "it happened," appears four more times in Luke 2:1-20. The point? This isn't a heartwarming story, an ancient myth, or the stuff of legend. This is fact. History. Truth.

And that's really good news. It means that there's a real Jesus, a real Savior, and a real hope for the real stuff you are going through. Dear Parents/Guardians, I wanted to make you aware that we were notified today that an individual at our school has tested positive for COVID-19. Update from Miss S.'s Classroom

The 4K classroom has had a whirlwind of activities the last 2 weeks! It has been a little bit of an adjustment practicing for the Christmas Service on December 19 and we are improving ever day! The parents will again get to hear the message that Jesus is our JOY.

We have been studying that the angel visited Zechariah and told of John's arrival. We are learning the Zoophonics animals, actions, and letter sounds. Currently we are reviewing /g/ sound as in gorilla. We have also been reading or looking for letters we know. We have been writing in the air, on the ground, with playdoh, with chalk, and with pencils. We use the program Learning Without Tears to support the learning style of older threes and young 4s. It has been fun graphing, identifying more and less, counting/matching objects. We do many hands-on activities to solidify concepts in our minds. Parents either see the work on paper or as evidence on Brightwheel, the Preschool's communication tool between parents and teachers. In science, we are discovering the animals God made, currently it is Gordo Gorilla. In social studies, we learn how to care for one another, how to understand what we need, and how to communicate our needs.
