PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE:

Pay attention to God's "wonderful deeds"

"I will give thanks to you, Lord, with all my heart; I will tell of all your wonderful deeds. I will be glad and rejoice in you; I will sing the praises of your name, O Most High" (Psalm 9:1,2).

These are King David's words. How do they apply to me? How would things change if I spent more time praising God *and* telling of his wonderful deeds as David did? How do *I* go about giving thanks to the Lord with all my heart?

Thank you for working with us to keep everyone here healthy, to the best of our ability!






Update from Mrs. Bohl's Classroom


