Devotion: You Can Have Whatever You Ask For!

Prepare a list in your head of the presents you want for your birthday. What is on your list? Most wish lists can be divided into three categories: those things you know you will get, those things you hope you will get, and those things you will not get... but it is fun to dream!

What if I told you that God wants you to prepare a list and whatever you ask for, you will get? That's right, you can ask God for anything according to his will, and he promises that you will get whatever you ask for.

Did you catch the caveat? The apostle John writes, "This is the confidence we have in approaching God: that if we ask anything according to his will, he hears us. And if we know that he hears us—whatever we ask—we know that we have what we asked of him." The doors of God's blessings stand wide open, but ... only when we ask for things "according to his will." There is a limit to what we can demand and know that God will give us. The limit is "God's will." We can find God's will (or his promises) laid out in his Word. So, we can ask for a million dollars—and God may even give it to us—but we have no promise in his Word that a million dollars is God's will for us.


What, then, can we ask for with the certainty that God will give us? Here is a short list:

- You can ask that people teach God's Word correctly and lead lives in line with that Word.
- You can request God the Father to send the Holy Spirit so that people believe the Word and live godly lives.
- You can call on God to destroy all the evil plans of his enemies.
- You can demand that God give you all the things that you need for your earthly welfare.
- You can insist that God forgive you all your sins.
- You can pray that God protects you from the plots of those who would pull you away from the faith.
- You can order God to deliver you from those things that threaten your faith and, in the end, that God would take you to heaven.

The list above may not include a million dollars. But it includes something far better-heaven itself. It is yours for the asking!

Utilizing our schools for outreach

What a blessing and opportunity the Lord provides in our early childhood ministries and our schools to share the gospel with children and their families. Do you sometimes wonder if there are ways to connect with those families and connect families to the Word?

Telling the Next Generation is a ministry provided by the Commission on Lutheran Schools. The program serves congregations of the WELS with planning, assistance, and resources for implementation of a harvest strategy utilizing their Lutheran elementary school and/or early childhood ministry.

The presenters are WELS church and school leaders who are experienced with conducting school ministries with an outreach focus. The workshop is designed to provide congregational teams ways to focus their ministry and create a harvest strategy.

The workshop includes sessions:

- Committed to the Word The Word is the means that the Holy Spirit uses to work/grow faith in the hearts of its audience. The Word teaches us the true definition of our church/school mission and guides us in our vision for carrying it out. It's the Word that empowers our faith and directs our lives to serve Jesus and the people he leads us to reach with the good news of his salvation.
- Relationships Relationships are vital to an effective outreach and harvest strategy. These relationships include those among faculty, staff, school, and church leadership. They work together as an organized and determined team focusing on building relationships with school and ECM families to connect them with the gospel of Jesus.
- 3. Harvest Strategies A practical guide for congregations and schools to build relationships with the school children and their families, to develop an organized program for nurturing those relationships, and to strive to lead them to instruction in the Word. It's the Word that unites and motivates people doing ministry and compels them by the love ofChrist to use the gospel in strategic ways to harvest souls for the kingdom.

In the months following the workshop, advisors follow-up with congregations in order to answer questions, supply resources, and give advice for fulfilling the goals that were discussed and planned at the workshops.


