

Christian Conduct Covenant (Behavior Policy)

In the spirit of Ephesians 5, recognizing that I am to be an "imitator of God", desiring to let God's Word guide my life, and striving to live a life of thanks for all God has done for me in Christ, I promise, with the help of the Holy Spirit, to....

- Participate positively in all the spiritual growth presentations and related classes.
- Participate positively in all recreational and social activities planned.
- Cooperate with and follow the directions of camp leaders and Director
- Report inappropriate behavior to the camp leaders and Director
- Assist in whatever ways asked to help make the camp a success.
- Abide by the following rules, regulations, and requirements:
- Respect campsite/school-church property.
- Treat everyone in and out of camp in a God pleasing manner.
- Behave as a Christian model of my faith, both on and off campus.

As the parent/guardian of this camper, I have read and discussed the expectations of participating in Reformation's Summer Camp. My agreement on the acknowledgment page declares that I understand and will uphold the guidelines here stated. If my child does not adhere to the guidelines set in this contract, I understand that we may be asked to leave Summer Camp and may forfeit some of the Summer Camp expenses already incurred.

Liability Wavier

By agreeing to policy I am informed of the activities offered by Reformation Lutheran Summer Camp (hereinafter "this camp", "church", "school", ect.) located at 4670 Mount Abernathy Ave San Diego, Ca 92117, beginning on June 8, 2020 and ending August 21, 2020.

As the parent or legal guardian of my child(ren), I hereby consent for my child(ren) to attend and participate in all activities by this (Camp, Church, School, ect) including occasional off-campus field trips (park, library, at a specific location or a neighborhood walk), while under the supervision of the Reformation Staff during the weeks of June 8 through August 21, 2020. I do further agree to hold and save harmless the staff and teachers of Reformation Lutheran Church, School, and Summer Camp from any suits, claims or demands of every kind and character arising out of or in connection with said function in which my child(ren) shall take part in.

Photo Release

I understand that pictures of my child may be used on Facebook, Instagram, and/or on the school/church website, or on promotional materials, printed by the school, unless I give a written request to the Director asking that my child's picture not be used on these types of medias. (Please submit this request letter prior to the first day of camp.)

Discounts and credits available:

- Each month you sign up for you receive our monthly price of \$750.
- Additional child discount: \$50 per 4 weeks attended by more than one child in same family
- Discounts for second child must be requested to summercamp@refsd.org after registration and payment have been completed. Discounts and credits will be given as a partial refund to payment method used for camp registration.

Cancellations

Registration fee is refundable up to 7 days prior to the week or day of camp for which a child is registered. Cancellation and refund must be requested in writing to summercamp@refsd.org. No refunds for partial week attendance - if a student is registered for and has paid for one week of camp, no refund will be provided for days missed due to illness or other reason other than a death in the family

Field Trips

Unfortunately there will be no field trips this year due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Medication

Should your camper need to take medication during the program, the Director will administer it as directed. The following items are essential for us to dispense any medication:

- The medication will need to be checked in with the Director. Please do not leave the medication with your camper, including over the counter medication, epi-pens, inhalers, creams, eye drops, etc.

- Medication must be in its original container with labeled prescription instructions
 - A completed Student Incidental Medical Treatment Notification & Training Form provided with directions on how to administer the medication.
- PLEASE UPDATE YOUR CHILD'S PROFILE WITH CURRENT AUTHORIZED PICKUPS AND EMERGENCY CONTACTS (to do this select children, then select the 3 dots in the corner of your child's profile to edit information).**

Drop Off and Pick Up

AUTHORIZATION TO PICK UP CAMPER

Only adults who are authorized under your child's profile by the parent will be allowed to pick up your camper. All adults picking up campers from camp are required to identify themselves with a photo ID.

SIGN-IN AND SIGN-OUT PROCEDURES-Back lot only on the back side of campus.

Summer camp drop off and pick up will happen at the backside on campus.

In order to ensure the safety of your camper, it is mandatory that each camper be signed in and out daily with a legal signature and time by an authorized adult (18 years or older).

Remember camp starts at 8:00 am - please get your business matters completed before then as we will be starting Bible devotion from 8:00 to 8:15 am.

What to Prepare For

Clothing

Summer Camp dress code: you must exercise good Christian "taste". No logos that would cause offense. No mid-drift shirts or high cut shorts. Simply, use common sense and dress for athletics and in clothes you can freely move around in. If skirts or dresses are worn, shorts are mandatory underneath.

For health and safety, **closed-toe shoes** are the only acceptable form of footwear. All shoes must have a heel strap. This is not only for your child's protection, but because of the activities your child will be participating in on a daily basis. The only exception to this rule is when your child is participating in water activities.

The Director and Staff reserve the right to have a child change into other clothes if they deem the child's clothing is inappropriate and not God pleasing.

Lunch

Your child will need to bring a morning and afternoon snack as well as a lunch. Please have your child bring a water bottle, that can be filled up. It gets quite hot outside and we want the children to stay hydrated.

As an option we offer the snack shop, where your child can buy snacks or a hot lunch. This is completely voluntary. If you would like your child to participate you will pay online, and will receive a punch card to fill out with the amount that was purchased, allergies, and any foods you would not like your child to have. You will turn in your child's punch card to Mrs. E who will keep track of your child's spending. Please sign up no later than Sunday for the upcoming week. Punch cards will carry over from week to week if there is unused fund left over on the punch card.

Sun Protection

Parents should apply sunscreen before campers arrive to camp in the morning. We apply sunscreen multiple times throughout the day. If you do not want sunscreen applied to your camper, or would like a special type of sunscreen applied, please send a note to your child's Camp Unit Leader each Monday and provide them with the special sunscreen. **Please also provide your child with sunscreen, clearly labeled with their name on it.**

What Not to Bring to Camp

NO ELECTRONICS!!! (If any are brought on campus, staff will confiscate them and turn them into the director. The director will make the judgment call if they will be returned at the end of the day or not.) The only exception is if there is an electronics day, notices will be sent out prior to that day.

Please do NOT bring any toys from home as staff are not responsible for any loss or damage of toys. The only exception is if there is an open play day to bring toys, upon which notices will be sent out prior to that day.
